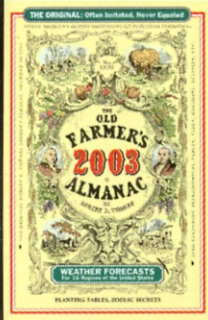

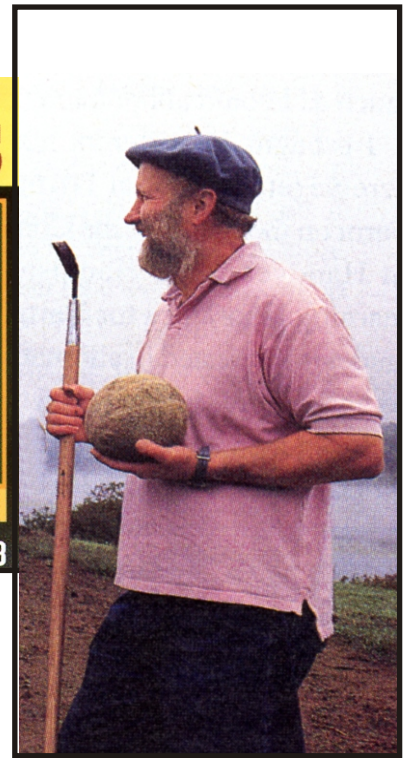

**Henningsen Circlehoe**  
(11), designed and made  
by a market farmer who is



also a blacksmith. Its circular shape allows it to cut weed roots close to plants while keeping the cutting part away from plant roots. Its shape also allows a person to get in tight to a plant and pull forward, slicing weed roots just beneath the soil. I like it, as did Scott. It is lightweight, sturdy, and easy to control.
